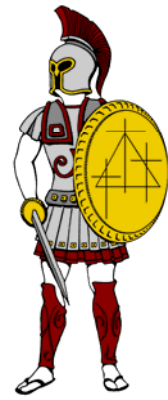

From the Principal

*The fruit of the Spirit is ... Self Control.
(Galatians 5:22,23)*

At Trinity Lutheran School, we teach children to make good and wise choices and urge students to exhibit self control. We may say:

- Control your anger. Show love.
- Control your tongue. Be kind.
- Control your use of time. Use your God-given abilities.
- Control your silliness. Have enjoy life.

The child may then ask, “Why is self control so important?” What would your answer be?

Our lives are filled with choices. We need to exhibit self control in our decision making. Some decisions don’t involve right or wrong: hamburger or hot dog, Disney World or Sea World, poodle or Dalmatian. However, many decisions have a spiritual, moral dimension: church or sleep, generosity or selfishness, mercy or revenge. How can we possibly make God-pleasing decisions or teach our children to exhibit self control? God, through His Word, gives us the strength and guidance to be self-controlled.

Paul’s letter to Titus has specific instructions for people of all ages as they follow the teachings (doctrine) of God’s Word. Notice how a self-controlled life is a life filled with good works.

“But as for you, teach what accords with sound doctrine. Older men are to be sober-minded, dignified, self-controlled, sound in faith, in love, and in steadfastness. Older women likewise are to be reverent in behavior, not slanderers or slaves to much wine. They

are to teach what is good, and so train the young women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind, and submissive to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be reviled. Likewise, urge the younger men to be self-controlled. Show yourself in all respects to be a model of good works, and in your teaching show integrity, dignity, and sound speech that cannot be condemned, so that an opponent may be put to shame, having nothing evil to say about us. (Titus 2:1-8)

May all people see the love of Christ in what we do and say. May Trinity Lutheran School continue to be a place where children learn of the love of Christ which leads to a self-controlled life filled with good works.
