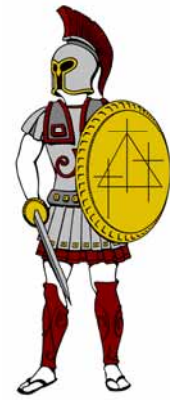

**BABYSITTER'S TRAINING COURSE** offered by Sheboygan County Chapter ARC will be held on Monday, June 21<sup>st</sup> OR Tuesday, July 20<sup>th</sup> from 8:30am-3:00pm at the Red Cross (2032 Erie Avenue, Sheboygan). The cost is \$30.00 and includes handbook with a CD-ROM and Reference Guide. If you would like a pizza lunch, add \$3.00 to the class cost above. This course instructs youth on how to care for infant through school aged children by teaching them how to prevent injuries and what to do in an emergency. They will also learn how to change diapers, feed children, discipline, and how to handle emergencies and basic first aid. To be eligible for this class, it is recommended that participants be at least 11 years old. Class size is limited to 12 students so early registration is recommended. Registration forms are available in the school office.
