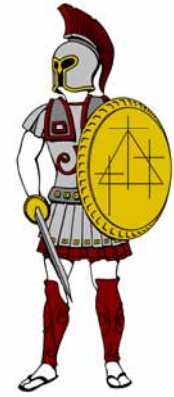

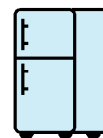
SCHOOL PICTURES

DROP OFF & PICK UP PROCEDURES

Grades 3K-K: If you are walking into the building to drop off or pick up your child(ren), you MUST park your vehicle in a parking space in the lot.



Do not park in the drop off area near the awning – this makes it impossible for parents to drop off and drive through. If you have

questions about the procedure, please contact your child's teacher.

Grades 1-8: Students can be dropped off at either the front or back doors of the main school building. If arriving before 8:15am, all students must go to the gym for before school care (unless other arrangements have been made with a teacher for homework questions). Parking is available in the library parking lot, but if you leave your vehicle and don't plug the meter, you may get a ticket. Please remember to use safety and caution when driving in the lot and follow the directions of the safety patrol. If you walk across the street to pick up your child, please use only the cross walks as Wisconsin state law requires. Thank you.
