- ❖ Scrip order cut off time is Sunday 10:45am. Scrip orders are placed every Sunday afternoon. The gifts cards usually come in on Wednesday or Thursday afternoon. Please make sure your online order is paid either by Presto Pay or drop off a check to Trinity before Sunday. Orders will not be placed without payment. You may also order by paper form with check payment. Limited inventory of gift cards are available for purchase on Sundays in the lounge. Scrip is also available for purchase during the school day when Mrs. Rindt is in the school office.
- ❖ Anyone purchasing Scrip during the week may do so by calling or emailing Mrs. Rindt (458-8248 or [school@trinitysheboygan.org](mailto:school@trinitysheboygan.org)) an hour or two in advance.
