We would like to thank Janelle and Kelly Koren for their generous donation of a Promethean Board (interactive white-board) to Trinity Lutheran School. The board was installed in the 6th grade homeroom and is used daily by the teachers and students. The board allows teachers and students to view and manipulate information that is displayed on the board that is connected to a computer. The teachers and students can even control the board wirelessly from a distance via a slate called ActivSlate. Additionally, images and objects can be displayed on the board using a specially designed camera called ActiView. We are excited about the enhanced learning that will occur due to this new piece of technology. This is the third such device that is in use at Trinity.
