Toner and Inkjet Cartridge Recycling

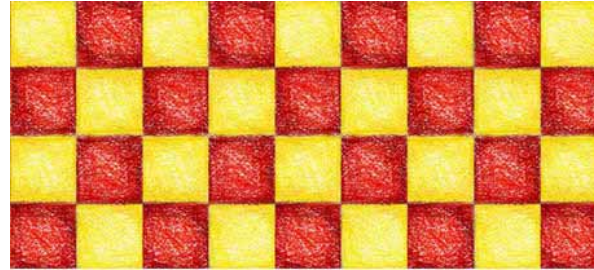
