




## From the Pastors

### I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say...

Jesus said, “My sheep hear My voice, I know them, they follow Me. I give them eternal life” (John 10:10).

Dear Brothers and Sisters of our Lord Jesus Christ,



When a pastor speaks God’s Word, we hear the voice not merely of a man but of God Himself. Preaching is the work of the Lord Christ, who is still active in and through His Word. The mouth of every preacher is the mouth of God Himself. Martin Luther once said, “When a lowly pastor comforts me, then I must be discerning enough to say, ‘It is not you who is speaking to me. The voice is yours indeed, but it is really God who is speaking through you.’”

This month, as we celebrate the Reformation, we rejoice again in proclaiming Scripture alone! For our Lord’s words alone deliver His gifts of salvation, and they are still spoken today. As the writer to the Hebrews reminds us, “Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by His Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world” (Hebrews 1:1-2). Our Lord is still speaking whenever and wherever His Word is proclaimed in its truth and purity. This is of great comfort to us. For example, a pastor entered a room of someone in hospice care distraught over her unbelief. He reminded her that none of the disciples in the upper room of that first Easter Sunday believed, either. Jesus went to them, spoke to them, and made believers out of them. This pastor, by the Holy Spirit at work through God’s word, was there to do the same for her. The preaching and teaching of God’s word makes believers out of us, that is, receivers of God’s forgiveness, life, and peace.

A favorite hymn of a former elder at Trinity, now in the Church Triumphant, was “I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say.” It’s easy to see why. It delivers the comfort and peace of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. “I heard the voice of Jesus say, ‘Come unto Me and rest; Lay down thou weary one, lay down Thy head upon my breast.’ I came to Jesus as I was, so weary, worn, and sad; I found in Him a resting place, and He has made me glad” (LSB #699 verse 1).

Check out those smiles! The JOY of the Lord is contagious!


